

Ordinance No. 111

An ordinance providing for a general municipal election to be held in the City of Marcellton, Oregon, on Wednesday December 19th 1913, and naming the Election Board.

The City of Marcellton does ordain as follows:

Section 1 That a general Municipal election for the City of Marcellton, Oregon, shall be held on Wednesday December 19th 1913, at which election shall be elected, a Mayor, two councilmen for a term of two years, and two Councilmen for the term of one year.

Section 2 That the City shall be said it is hereby designated as the place for holding said election.

Section 3 That the date of said election shall be Saturday noon, and service more, and the judges of said election shall be J. H. Coffey, John Green, and Henry Lee.

Section 4 That J. H. Coffey shall be chairman of said election board, and has the full responsibility and authority.

Section 5 That the Auditor and Police Judge shall give notice of such election by posting such notices in three public places within the City of Marcellton for a period of at least twenty prior to said election.

Section 6 That the term of Office shall be as follows:

short for one Mayor.

Mr. Mayor. - Not for me. One year terms

Mr. Brewster. - Not for us. Two year terms

Mr. Brewster. - Vote for us. One year terms

Section of Any political party shall file with the Auditor and
Public Judge, a list of its nominees, as provided for under
the general election laws of this State; said Auditor shall
have printed a ballot to conform as closely as practicable
with the form above set forth, and which said ballot
shall have printed thereon the list of candidates of
such political party or parties, provided however that
said ballot shall be printed by parties, shall hand in his list
of other candidates to said Auditor and Public Judge
at least one week prior to the date of such election.
