An Ordinance Establishing Rules and Regulations for the Warrenton Dog Park, Operating Hours,
and Providing for Penalties

Whereas, The Warrenton City Commission finds it is necessary to implement rules and regulations for the Warrenton Dog Park for public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WARRENTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Rules and Regulations

The Rules and Regulations for the Warrenton Dog Park are attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. Park Hours

Dog Park Hours of Operation shall be 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Section 3. Violations/Fines

Any person who violates this ordinance commits a violation punishable by a fine of not more than \$100.00. A second offense will result in subject being banned from use of the facility for a one year period.

Section 4. Effective Date


This ordinance shall be in full force and effect 30 days after its adoption.
