AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ALL EXAGGERATED OR DISORDERLY  
DANCES OR DANCING AND PROVIDING PUNISHMENT FOR VIOLA-  
TION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

*Prohibiting Disorderly dances & use of tobacco*

Section 1. That all persons be, and they hereby are,  
prohibited from dancing any exaggerated or disorderly dances,  
being such dances as are commonly known as ragging dances,  
and ordinarily called: the pivot, walk-back, Frisco walk,  
shivers, hyppo dip, jelly wiggle, sun fish squirm, bunny hug,  
turkey trot, heads together, port and starboard, side show,  
briny deep, corkscrew twirl, angle worm wiggle, grizzly bear  
and Texas Tommy.

*Sec. 2. No person shall use tobacco in any form  
in any dance hall or room where public dances  
are held or permitted within the City of Warrenton.  
Violation & Penalty.*

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions  
of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof by the auditor and  
police judge, shall be fined not less than \$2.00, or more  
than \$25.00, or by imprisonment in the city jail for not more  
than fifteen days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in  
the discretion of the court.
