3 Ordinance Number 121A

5 An Ordinance levying taxes for General Municipal  
6 purposes and for bond interest, sinking fund and other  
7 purposes for the City of Warrenton for year 1927, upon the  
8 1926 tax roll, confirming, approving and adopting the  
9 budget as prepared, submitted and acted upon by the  
10 Levying Board and Budget Committee of the City of Warrenton,  
11 and declaring an emergency.

12 THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

13 Section I: That there be and is hereby levied a tax for  
14 general municipal purposes for the City of Warrenton, Oregon  
15 for year 1927 upon the 1926 tax roll the sum of \$ 2697588.  
16 and that there be and is hereby levied a tax for bond  
17 interest purposes for the City of Warrenton for year 1927  
18 upon the 1926 tax roll the sum of \$ 35545.40, and that  
19 there be and is hereby levied a tax for sinking fund and  
20 other purposes (not general municipal) the sum of \$ NONE  
21 for year 1927 upon the 1926 tax roll, and that said tax, as  
22 aforesaid, is hereby duly levied upon all of the taxable  
23 property within the limits of the City of Warrenton, Clatsop  
24 County, State of Oregon.

25 Section II. That the budget for general municipal expenses  
26 and purposes, bond interest, sinking fund and other purposes  
27 (not general) for the City of Warrenton, Oregon for year 1927  
28 upon the 1926 tax roll, as prepared, submitted and adopted  
29 by the Levying Board and Budget Committee of the City of  
30 Warrenton be and the said budget is hereby approved, confirmed  
31 and adopted, and is hereby referred to and made a part of  
32 this tax levying ordinance as though set out in full herein.

3 Section III. That the Auditor & Police Judge of the City of  
4 Warrenton be and he is hereby directed to notify, in writing,  
5 the County Assessor and the County Clerk of the County of  
6 Clatsop, State of Oregon, of the amount of money proposed  
7 to be raised by taxation, not later than the first day of  
8 December, 1926.

9 Section IV. Inasmuch as the objects to be obtained by this  
10 ordinance will be of great benefit to the City of Warrenton,  
11 and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this  
12 ordinance should take effect as soon as possible so that the  
13 government of the City of Warrenton may properly function,  
14 and so that the health, peace and safety of the people of  
15 the City of Warrenton may be preserved, an emergency is  
16 hereby declared to exist and this section therefore should  
17 take effect when approved by the affirmative vote of four  
18 of the members of the Commission of the City of Warrenton,  
19 and this ordinance shall then be in full force and operative  
20 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor of  
21 the City of Warrenton,
