
AN ORDINANCE authorising the painting of the outside of the City Hall in the City of Warrenton, and providing for the payment of the Costs and expenses of the same.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS-----

Section 1.....That there be and there is hereby made,an improvement to the City Hall, by covering the outside walls thereof with one or more coats of painf.

Section 2.....That said outside of said City Hall shall be painted in accordancewith the plans and specifications as prepared by the Committee on Sanitation and Public Property,now in the handsof the Auditor and Police Judge,and in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 3.....That said committee be and it is hereby ordered to call for bids for the painting of the said City Hall,and the Auditor & Police Judge be and he is hereby ordered to advertise for such bids under the direction of said Committee,which advertisement shall be published by posting public notices thereof in three public places in the City of Warrenton Oregon. Thatthe bids for this work shall be sealed bids and shall be handed to the Auditor & Police Judge on or before 10 days after the posting of such notices.

Section 4.... That said Committee shall open said bids at such time as may be deemed convenient,and report on the same, together with their recommendations at the next meeting of the Council.

Section 5..... That on the approval of the recommendations of said ~~said~~ Committee by a majority of the Council, the contract shall be let to the lowest responsible bidder, but the Council reserves to itself ~~the~~ the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 6..... That upon the receipt of a report from the Committee on Sanitation and Public Property,that the above work has been completed to their satisfaction,and upon the approval of said report,

Section 6.....(continued) by the Council at their regular meeting,

and within 60 days from the approval of such report; The Auditor & Police Judge be and he is hereby authorised to issue a Warrant on the General Fund for the payment of said Contract.

Section 7.... That an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and that the condition of the aforesaid City Hall in conjunction with the approaching rainy season, requires that this Ordinance should take effect as soon as passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor. That this section shall go into effect as soon as approved by the affirmative vote of 13/5ths of the members of the Common Council, and this ordinance shall be of full force and effect on its approval by the Common Council and its being signed by the Mayor.
