

ORDINANCE NO. 109.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THIRD STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH DATE STREET TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH ELM STREET; THE IMPROVEMENT OF ELM STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH SECOND STREET TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH WALNUT STREET; THE IMPROVEMENT OF SECOND STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH WALNUT STREET TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH LARCH STREET; THE IMPROVEMENT OF FIRST STREET TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH WALNUT STREET WITH LARCH STREET, THENCE TO A POINT 100 FEET WEST OF THE WEST BOUNDARY OF LARCH STREET; BY CONSTRUCTING A SIX-FOOT SIDEWALK ON ONE SIDE ONLY OF SAID STREETS.

WHEREAS, due and regular notice of the election and intention of the Common Council of the City of Warrenton to improve the streets herein after described by laying a six-foot sidewalk along one side thereof, in accordance with a resolution duly adopted by said Council on the 7th day of December, 1914, and from the proof of publication of said Council's intention to improve said streets as aforesaid, now on file with the Auditor made and filed estimates of the cost of constructing said improvement, together with specifications for same, and no remonstrance having been filed against said improvement, and the time for filing such remonstrance having elapsed, therefore,

THE CITY OF WARRENTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That said streets be forthwith improved by laying and constructing a sidewalk over and along only side of that portion of the streets described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing on Third Street at the point where it intersects Date Street, thence along North ~~the~~ side of Third Street to its intersection with Elm Street; thence beginning on the West ~~the~~ side of Elm Street where such street intersects Third Street and continuing along that side to its intersection with Second Street; improvement of Second Street to along the South ~~the~~ side thereof, from its intersection with Elm Street to its intersection with Walnut Street; improvement of Walnut Street, along the West ~~the~~ side thereof, from its intersection with Second Street to its intersection with First Street; improvement of First Street from its intersection with Walnut Street, along the South ~~the~~ side of First Street, to its intersection with Larch Street, to a point 100 feet west of the west boundary of Larch Street.

Section 2. That said Committee be, and the same hereby is, authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement by posting notices in three conspicuous places within said city for a period of ten successive days, to receive bids for said improvement and to report the same to the Council and, upon the acceptance of the lowest bid by the Council, to enter into a contract with such bidder for the construc-

tion of the improvement.

Section 3. The contract shall provide that said improvement shall be constructed and completed to the satisfaction of said Committee, and that such improvement shall be completed on or before the 31st day of March, 1915, unless the time be extended by ordinance, and for each day's delay in the completion of said improvement, unless the time be extended as aforesaid, the contractor shall forfeit and pay to the City of Warrenton, as stipulated damages for such delay, the sum of \$250; that said improvement shall be made strictly in accordance with said plans and specifications and this ordinance, and the contractor shall have full charge of the work and shall be responsible for all accidents and injuries occurring upon said street during the progress of the work, and save the City of Warrenton harmless from all damages on account of injury or injuries to any person or persons occurring upon the said portions of the aforementioned streets to be improved as aforesaid, while the improvement is being made.

Section 4. That payments for said improvement shall be made in warrants of the City of Warrenton, upon a special fund constituted to defray the cost of the improvement, or upon the general fund, or partly upon each fund, and that payment be made within ninety (90) days from the time the improvement shall be accepted.

Section 5. Contractors shall be required to give bond with two or more sureties in the sum of \$4000, conditioned for the faithful performance of said contract.

That any planking and timbers upon any portion of said streets to be improved as aforesaid, after the same is taken up by the contractor, may be taken by the City of Warrenton and removed, and all old planks and timbers required by the city, and all rubbish upon the streets, after the improvement is completed, shall be removed by the contractor.

Section 6. That the Committee on Streets and Public Ways is hereby authorized and directed to make and levy, in pursuance of Section 51 of the Charter, as amended in 1901, a special assessment for the purpose of paying for said improvement, upon the real property abutting thereon, and

more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Lots 31 and 32 in Block 4 of Warren's First Extension to
the City of Warrenton; and
Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 in Block 136;
Lots 1 and 16 in Block 136;
Lot 1 in Block 135;
Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 in Block 123;
Lots 1 and 16 in Block 123
Lots 1 and 16 in Block 124
Lot 1 in Block 125;
Lot 8 in Block 112; ~~and~~ in Warren's Second Extension to the City of Warrenton, Oregon.

Section 7. That the aggregate sum to be assessed against said property shall be ~~determined by~~ ^{who} Said Committee shall make said assessment and report the same to the Council as soon as practicable.
