AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2091 BY  
INCLUDING A SPECIAL NON-PEAK  
INDUSTRIAL RATE AND  
REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 2004

WHEREAS, The City of Warrenton desires to set an industrial rate during non-peak water useage in the months of April/May specific to shrimp processors inside the City limits; and

WHEREAS, in review of the City of Warrenton water rate resolutions certain housekeeping matters are necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


1. Resolution No. 2004 is hereby repealed.
2. Resolution No. 2091 is hereby amended by adding the following customer class and rate for the months of April and May:

| Range/Customer Class                    | Volume Rate | Outside City |
|---|-------------|--------------|
|   | Inside City |              |
| <b>2,001 gallons and over:</b>          |             |              |
| Non-peak Industrial (shrimp processor): | \$ 2.15     | N/A          |

3. The non-peak industrial rate for shrimp processing will be gauged by a water meter installed specifically for use in shrimp processing. Such meter installation shall be applied for and approved by the City of Warrenton Public Works Director.

The resolution is effective as of April 1, 2008.
