4 APPROVING THE
5 DESIGNATION OF PROPERTY WITHIN
6 THE CITY OF WARRENTON AS A
7 COUNTY PARK

8 WHEREAS Clatsop County owns a parcel of real property located in the City of Warrenton
9 commonly known as Delaura Beach; and

10 WHEREAS the parcel is currently used by the public for beach access and recreational activities;
11 and

12 WHEREAS the Clatsop County Parks and Recreational Lands Master Plan recommends the
13 property be designated as a county park; and

14 WHEREAS the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department wishes to purchase the county's Delaura
15 Beach property to manage as part of the Fort Stevens State Park; and

16 WHEREAS the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department will agree to continue to provide public
17 beach access, and to make fire protection improvements; and


18 WHEREAS, Oregon Parks and Recreation Department will form an advisory committee to provide
19 input on Delaura Beach property management issues which will include a representative appointed by the
20 Warrenton City Commission; and

21 WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners wishes to proceed with the county park
22 designation process pursuant to ORS 275.330 and requests that the City of Warrenton Commission adopt a
23 resolution approving of the designation of the County's Delaura Beach property as a county park pursuant to
24 ORS 275.320.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Warrenton City Commission approves of the
26 designation of the property described on the attached Exhibit A, commonly known as Delaura Beach, as a
27 county park pursuant to ORS 275.320.


