AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2261 BY  
INCLUDING A SPECIAL NON-PEAK  
INDUSTRIAL RATE AND  
REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 2215

WHEREAS, The City of Warrenton set an industrial rate during non-peak water usage for the months of April and May by Resolution No. 2215 in 2008, specific to shrimp processors inside the City limits; and

WHEREAS, very little water is used for shrimp processing in the month of April; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of the very important economic role this industry has in the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


1. Resolution No. 2262 is hereby amended by adding the following customer class and rate for the months of April, May, and June.

<b>2,001 gallons and over:</b>		
Non-peak Industrial (shrimp processor):	\$ 2.26	N/A


2. The non-peak industrial rate for shrimp processing will be gauged by a water meter installed specifically for use in shrimp processing.
3. Any rate increase to customer classes in Resolution No. 2262 will also apply to this Non-peak Industrial class.
4. Resolution No. 2215 is hereby repealed.

The resolution is effective immediately upon its passage.
