APPROVING INCREASES AND DECREASES TO THE 2010-2011 BUDGET BY MAKING AN INTRAFUND TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Commission of the City of Warrenton hereby adopts the following 2010-2011 budget changes to the Building Department Fund to transfer \$22,500 from contingency to the line item "Capital Equipment" in the Capital Outlay category to provide spending authority for the purchase of a vehicle for the Building Inspector.

This adjustment reduces the budgetary appropriations in the Building Department Fund contingency by \$22,500:

APPROVING INCREASES AND DECREASES TO THE 2010-2011 BUDGET BY MAKING AN INTRAFUND TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Commission of the City of Warrenton hereby adopts the following 2010-2011 budget changes to the Quincy Robinson Fund to transfer \$15,074 from contingency to the line item "Camp Host Install-City Park" in the capital outlay category to provide for additional spending authority for a Park Model. This will bring the existing budgeted amount of \$11,000 to a total of \$26,074. This will reduce the budgetary appropriations in contingency to \$0.

ORDINANCE NO. 1152-A

Introduced by Commissioner: Terry Ferguson

An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 1147-A, Section 3, Installation and Maintenance
of New Service

The City of Warrenton Ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 1147-A is amended to read as follows:

Section 3. INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE

1. Installation: A new service may be installed upon application and payment of the current water tap fee. Upon payment thereof, the water department will furnish all labor and materials necessary for such installation. All meters shall be installed only in the public right-of-way adjacent to: (1) the property to be served, or (2) a recorded easement which allows placement of utilities, which easement benefits the property to be served.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its passage.
