APPROVING AND ADOPTING INCREASES TO THE 2011-2012 BUDGET BY INCREASING APPROPRIATIONS FOR AN UNFORSEEN OCCURENCE

BE IT RESOLVED that the City Commission of the City of Warrenton hereby adopts the following 2011-2012 budget changes for an unforseen occurrence resulting from the continuation of costs associated with the South Water Reservoir Project. This project is state funded through loans. At the time of budget preparation for this fiscal year, it was anticipated that this project would be substantially complete and only enough funds for wrapping up the project were budgeted. However, the project was delayed due to the extended time frame of the completion of the pump station. This resolution increases loan proceeds-SZ9012 and transfers out-Capital Reserve Fund in the amount of \$1,774,230 in the Water Fund. It also increases transfers in-Water Fund and Capital Outlay-South Water Reservoir in the amount of \$1,774,230. The following additional appropriations will accommodate completion of the project within the new budgeted amounts:
