IMPLEMENTING FEES FOR RIGHT OF WAY (ROW) PERMITS AND PLAN REVIEW FEES

WHEREAS, the City of Warrenton owns and maintains all public infrastructure within a public right of way (ROW) or a public utility easement; and

WHEREAS, all work in a public right of way, other than a Capital Improvement or Local Improvement District Project, requires a permit issued by the City of Warrenton and all Utility Companies, contractors, property owners or developers should pay for the required plan review and inspection fees for work on the public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, all installation or modification of improvements that will be or are owned and maintained by the City of Warrenton related to a new development, subdivision or a Partition of property should be approved and inspected by the City of Warrenton; and

NOW. THEREFORE, the City Commission of the City of Warrenton does hereby resolve:

Section 1. For the right to perform work in an existing or proposed right of way or public utility easement, a permit and plan review fee is hereby imposed and shall be collected upon issuance of a ROW permit by the Public Works Department.

Section 2. The fee shall be in the amounts shown in the following table and shall be incorporated into the *City of Warrenton Public Works Department Engineering Specifications & Design Standards* as Appendix A - PERMIT & PLAN REVIEW FEES.
