

Ordinance Number 3-1

An ordinance fixing the compensation of the Commissioners of the City of Warrenton, Oregon, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows.

Section 1;- That the compensation of the Commissioners of the City of Warrenton be and the same is hereby fixed in the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars for each and every regular <sup>meeting</sup> ~~and special meeting~~ of the said Commission, at which the Commissioner shall be present; That the amount due each Commissioner shall be paid at the expiration of each month.

Section 2;- Inasmuch as the objects to be obtained by this ordinance will be of great benefit to the City of Warrenton and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this ordinance should take effect as soon as possible so that the Government of the City of Warrenton may properly function and so that ~~then~~ the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton may be preserved an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this section therefore shall take effect when approved by the affirmative vote of two members of the Commission of Warrenton, and this ordinance shall then be in full force and operative immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
