

ORDINANCE NO. 6A

AN ORDINANCE GIVING UNTO THE WARRENTON LUMBER COMPANY PERMISSION TO DO CERTAIN DREDGING IN FRONT OF AND IN VICINITY OF THE PROPERTY OWNED BY THE WAERENTON LUMBER COMPANY IN THE SKIPANON RIVER AND PROVIDING A BOND TO INDEMNIFY THE CITY OF WARRENTON AGAINST ANY DAMAGE THAT MIGHT ACCRUE BY REASON OF THE DREDGE. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS.

Section 1,

That the Warrenton Lumber Company is hereby granted permission to do certain dredging in the way of deepening the channel of the Skipanpn River in front of and in the vacinity of the Mill and the property owned or leased by the said Warrenton Lumber Company, conditioned , however, that the said Warrenton Lumber Company make ~~and~~ exicute and deliver to the City of Warrenton a good and sufficient Bond Idemnity, against any and all damages that might accrue to any person or persons, corporation or the City of Warrenton in any manner ~~ar~~ at all, by reason of the dredging or deepening of the said Channel, the Said Bond to be in the Sum of \$1000,00

Section 2;

Inasmuch as the objects to be obtainrd from this Ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the City of Warrenton and there exists, and is ~~an~~ urgent necessity that this Ordinance should take effect as soon as possible so that the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton may be preserved. an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this section shall therefor take effect when approved by the unanimous vote of the Commissioners present, and not less than ~~two~~ ~~three~~ members thereof, and this Ordinance shall then be in full force and operative immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
