Entitled,

An Ordinance Providing For The Time And Manner Of Improving Harrison Street From Albany Avenue To Salem Avenue In The City Of Warrenton?Oregon.

Whereas, notice of the intention of the City Council of the City of Warrenton, Oregon, to improve Harrison StreetnFrom The Street known as Albapy Avenue To Salem Avenue, in that part of said city known as East Warrenton, has been given by publication thereof in the Port Oregon Tribune, a weekly newspaper published in said city, for the time and in the manner by the charter of said city required, and

Whereas, no remonstrance against said proposed improvement has been made, or filed with the Auditor and Police Judge of said city within the time by said charter required, and

Whereas, the City Surveyor, under the direction of the council has made and deposited with the said Auditor and Police Judge plans and specifi cations for the proposed work upon said improvement and an estimate of the expense thereof and a map of the district to be assessed for the same, now therefore,

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1. That Harrison Street From Albany Avenue To Salem Avenue, in the City of Warrenton, Oregon, be and the same is hereby ordered improved by grading same to the established grade of said street from the North Edge of the present and existing planking on Albany Avenue to the intersection of said Harrison Street with the South Line of Salem Avenue, and planking said Harrison Street when so graded, to a width of eight feet on each side of a line drawn along the center of said Harrison Avenue from said Salem to Albany Avenue.

Sec. 2. Said improvement shall be constructed according to the plans and specifications therefor, which are now on file in the office of the Auditor and Police Judge of said city are hereby referred to and made a part and parcel of this ordinance, and all material to be used on said improvement shall be as in said specifications provided.

Sec. 3. Said improvement shall be completed on or before the $\frac{1+1}{2}$ day of $\frac{1+1}{2}$ day and for every day thereafter which the contractor for said improvement shall consume in the completion of the same, he shall forfeit to the said City of Warrenton, the sum of \$ $\frac{1+1}{2}$ to be deducted from the amount due him at the time of the payment for said work.

Sec. 4. The Committee on Streets and Public Improvements shall and they are hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement by publication of a notice therefor in the Port Oregon Tribune for one issue of said paper and said committee are hereby authorized for and on behalf of said city to enter into a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the construction of said improvement, pro gided that no bid shall be received or considered which shall exceed the estimate of the expense of said improvement now on file in the office of the said Auditor and Police Judge and hereby made a partbof this ordinance.

Sec. 5. The said work shall be done under the supervision of the Marshall of said city who is hereby made the inspector of said work, with power hereby granted to him to stop said work at any time he is satisfied that any work, or material is being done or used on said improvement which does not conform to this ordinance.

Sec. 6. Before entering into the contract for said improvement and as a condition precedent of its being in force and effect, the contractor shall execute to the city a bond in a sum equal to the contract price with two good and suffi ient survises, conditioned for the faithful performance of his contract and the provisions of this ordinance in the construction of said improvement.
