" Entitled,

An Ordinance providing for the time and manner of improveing Harrison street in said City of Warrenton, Oregon:, from the South side of Salem Avenue southerly to within four feet of center line of Albany Avenue.

Whereas notion of the intention of the common council of the City of Warrenton, Oregon:, to improve Harrison Street in said City from the South side of Salem Avenue southerly to within four feet of center line of Albany Avenue has been give by publication thereof by posting notices in three public places in said City for the time and in the manner by the charter of said City provided, and,

Whereas, No remonstronce against proposed improvement has been made of filed with the Auditor and Police Judge within the time by the charter of said City provided, and,

Whereas, the committee on Streets and Public improvements of the council of said City under the direction of said council have made and deposited with the Auditoe and Police Judge of said City estimes of the expense of said improvement and specifications for the proposed work now therefore The City of Warrenton ordain as follows:-

Sec:- 1 That Harrison street from the South side of Salem Avenue Southerly to within four feet of the center line of Albany Avenue in said City of Warrenton, Oregon:, be and the same is hereby ordered to be improved by them, by pkanking said Harrison Street to a width of four feet on each side of the center thread of Harrison Street with planks two inches thick by twelve inches in width by eight feet in lingth laid on three stringers three inches by six inches kmbedded in the ground an equal distance apart except where it intersects with the planking with Albany Avenue which shall be twenty feet wide and for the distance of twenty feet in length which shall be laid on $\pi \omega s$ stringers three by six inches said planking shall be securely nailed with five inch spikes in each plank all lumber used shall be good fir lumber and it shall not be necessary that the said improvement shall be constructed on the grade of said Street as heretofore established but it shall be sufficient to lay said improvement to conform to the surface of the ground as same now is except to make said surface uniform and passable for travel.

Sec:- 2 The said improvement shall be constructed as herein above provided and also according to the specification therefore which are now on file with the Auditor and Police Judge of said City which said specifications are hereby referred to and hereby made a part of this Ordinance and all material to be used on this improvement shall be as in said specifications provided:-

Sec 3:- The committee on Streets and public improvements of the said council are hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement by publication thereof by posting notices in three public places within said City for $A_{\rm even}$ days and said committee are hereby authorized for and on behalf of said city to enter into a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the construction of said work including furnishing material therefore provided that no bid shall be considered or contract awarded which shall exceed in amount the amount specified in the expense of said improvement now on file in the office of the Auditor and Police Judge.

Sec 4:- The said work shall be done under the supervision of the said committee on Streets and public improvements who shall receive no pay for their servises and they shall have the right to reject any material or work which do not conform to the provision of this Ordinance . Sec:-5 The said improvement shall be completed within fifteen days from the date of the execution of the contract therefore and for every day thereafter which the contracter for said improvement shall consume in the completion of said improvement he shall forfeit to the Gity of Warrenton to be deducted from the amount due for said work the sum of five dollars per day.

Sec-6:- The contractor for said improvement shall before entering upon the performences thereof execute to the city a bond with good and sufficient sureties to be approved which bond shall equal in the amount in the contract price of said improvement , condition for the faithfull performance of said contract and a forfeiture stipulated in said undertaking in case of failure to so perform such contract which bond shall be approved by said committee on Streets and public improvements
