

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING ASSESSMENT ROLL NUMBER FOUR (4), AND DIRECTING THE SAME TO BE SPREAD UPON THE DOCKET OF THE CITY LIENS AND COLLECTED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, heretofore and to-wit: on the 17th day of June, 1922, the City Commission of the City of Warrenton passed a resolution declaring its intentions of improving Railway Avenue from its intersection with the westerly boundary of the pavement now on Main Street, and thence southerly along the center of said Railway Avenue to its intersection with Third Street; thence westerly along the center of Third Street to its intersection with Ash Street; thence northerly along the center of Ash Street to its intersection with the center of Second Street; also Walnut Street, from its intersection with Third Street, thence northerly along the center of Walnut Street to its intersection with the center of First Street; also Elm Street, from its intersection with the center of Third Street; thence southerly to the center line of Fourth Street, by macadamizing the same along the center thereof, and

WHEREAS, The costs and expenses of making said improvement, together with all incidental expenses connected therewith amount to Seven Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-One Dollars and Thirty-EIGHT CENTS, and that the said costs and expenses of making said improvement are appraised and assessed against the property in said district, now, therefore,

THE CITY OF WARRANTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the assessment roll, made and prepared by V. H. Coffey, E. H. Flagg and E. S. Hamel, covering the costs and expenses of improving District No. 4 in the sum of Seven Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-One Dollars and Thirty-Eight Cents (\$7,651.38), the making of said improvement consisting of the improving of Railway Avenue, from its intersection with the westerly boundary of the pavement now on Main Street, thence Southerly

along the center of said Railway Avenue to its intersection with Third Street; thence westerly along the center of Third Street to its intersection with Ash Street; thence northerly along the center of Ash Street to its intersection with the center of Second Street; also, Walnut Street, from its intersection with Third Street, thence northerly along the center of Walnut Street to its intersection with the center of First Street; also Elm Street, from its intersection with the center of Third Street; thence southerly to the center line of Fourth Street, by macadamizing the same along the center thereof, and that the costs and expenses of making said improvement, together with all incidental expenses therewith amount to the sum of Seven Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-One Dollars and Thirty-Eight Cents (\$7,651.38), and that the costs and expenses of making said improvement have been appraised and assessed to the following properties in the amounts set opposite to each described lot as follows:

Section 2. That the City Commission heretofore has appointed the 17th day of April, 1923, at the Warrenton City Hall, at 7:30 P.M., as the time and place to meet as a Board of Equalization to confirm said assessment against above properties and to ~~consider~~ any written remonstrances, if there be any, against said assessment and equalization, and that all remonstrances have been duly considered by the Commission, and that said assessment roll against the above described properties is in all respects equitable and just, and the same was confirmed by the Board of Equalization and is hereby confirmed in every respect and ordered spread on the Docket of City Liens and collected, as provided by law.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the objects of this Ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the City of Warrenton, and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this Ordinance should take effect as soon as possible, so that the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton may be preserved, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance therefore shall take effect when approved by the affirmative vote of two (2) members of the Commission of the City of Warrenton, and this Ordinance shall then be in full force and operative immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.

Passed the Common Council this 17th day of April, A.D., 1923.
