

Ordinance Number 16.

Entitled.

An Ordinance Establishing The Grades Of Harrison Street, Railroad Avenue, Third Street, And Elm Street In The City Of Warrenton, Oregon:

The City of Warrenton Does Ordain As Follows:

Sec. 1. That the grade of Harrison Street in the City of Warrenton, Oregon, be and the same is hereby established at the following height above mean low, low water mark, which said mean low, low water mark is hereby declared to be the base of grades for said city to wit,
At the intersection of said Harrison Street with Albany Avenue, at nine feet.
At the South intersection of said Harrison Street with the Right of Way of the Astoria And Columbia River Rail-road Company, at twelve feet and at the North side of said intersection, at twelve feet.
At the intersection of said Harrison Street with Salem Avenue at nine feet, and thence on a level grade of nine feet to the intersection of Portland Avenue.

Sec. 2. That the grade of Railroad Avenue, in the said city of Warrenton, be and the same is hereby established at the following height above the base of grades mentioned in Section one of this ordinance, to wit:
At the intersection of said Railroad Avenue with Main Street, at nine feet, thence on a level grade of nine feet to the intersection of said Railroad Avenue with Third Street.

Sec. 3. That the grade of Third Street in the City of Warrenton, Oregon, be and the same is hereby established at the following height above the base of grades, mentioned in section one of this ordinance, to wit:
At the intersection of ~~Rxxxxxxx~~ said Third Street with Railroad Avenue, at nine feet.
At the intersection of said Third Street with Cedar Street, at ten feet.
At a point 100 feet Westerly from the West line of said Cedar Street, at Eight feet; thence on a level grade to the intersection of Third Street with Elm Street.

Sec. 4. That the grade of Elm Street, in said city of Warrenton, be and the same is hereby established at the following height above the base of grades mentioned in Section one of this ordinance, to wit, ^{Eight}
At the intersection of said Elm Street with ~~Fourth~~ Street, at ~~Nine~~ Feet, thence on a level grade of ~~nine~~ ^{eight} feet to the intersection of said Elm Street with the Right of Way, of the Flavel Branch of the Astoria And Columbia River Railroad, and the street running parallel with said right of way.

The Auditor and Police Judge shall, upon the passage and approval of this ordinance give public notice of the establishment of said grades by publication of the same in the "Port Oregon Tribune", a weekly newspaper, once.
Passed the Common Council the 16 day of May, 1899.
