

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT ALL BUILDINGS ERECTED WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON SHALL BE PROPERLY WIRED SO AS TO BE PROTECTED FROM ALL FIRE HAZARDS, AND INSPECTED BY AN INSPECTOR APPOINTED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON AT THE TIME OF THE INSTALLATION OF ALL WIRING, AND PROVIDING THAT A PERMIT SHALL BE ISSUED BY THE AUDITOR AND POLICE JUDGE OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON FOR THE PURPOSE OF WIRING AND TO CHARGE THEREFOR, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION-1-

That all buildings hereafter erected within the corporate limits of the City of Warrenton shall be wired so as to be protected from fire hazards on account of such wiring, and all wiring shall be properly insulated and installed so as to comply strictly with the requirements of the State Underwriters and State Fire Marshall rules.

SECTION-2-

That prior to the wiring of any building within the Corporate limits of the City of Warrenton there shall be secured by the owner or contractor or builder for such building a permit from the City Auditor and Police Judge of the City of Warrenton to wire such building, and that the owner, contractor or builder shall pay to the City of Warrenton the sum of \$1.00, and such building during the course of construction shall be opened at all times for inspection by the inspector, appointed either by the State Fire Marshall or by the City of Warrenton, to inspect such wiring and until such inspector has passed upon same and approved the same no electric current shall be turned unto said wiring and into said building.

SECTION-3-

Any person, firm, co-partnership or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a mis-

demeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not more than \$500.00 and not to exceed 100 days in the City Jail by the Auditor and Police Judge of the City of Warrenton and Securing

SECTION-3-

Inasmuch as the objects to be obtained from this Ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the City of Warrenton and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this Ordinance should take effect as soon as possible so that the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton may be preserved an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Section therefore shall take effect when approved by the unanimous vote of the Commission present and not less than three(3) members thereof, and this Ordinance shall then be in full force and operative immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
