

ORDINANCE NUMBER 22A

PROVIDING FOR THE  
AN ORDINANCE/PURCHASING FIRE EQUIPMENT FOR THE CITY OF WARRENTON  
AND DIRECTING THE CITY MAYOR AND THE CITY AUDITOR AND POLICE  
JUDGE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH Stutz Fire Engine Company  
FOR THE PURCHASE OF SAME AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS.

SECTION 1.

That the Mayor and Auditor and Police Judge of the  
City of Warrenton be and they are hereby authorized and directed  
to enter into contract with Stutz Fire Engine Company  
*it being the lowest and best bidder for the required equipment*  
for the purchase of fire equipment for the City of Warrenton  
bids previously having been asked for by publication in the  
"Warrenton News", a newspaper printed and published in the City  
of Warrenton, and of general circulation therein as is shown  
by the Affidavit of Publisher now on file with the Auditor and  
Police Judge. The consideration for the purchase of said equip-  
ment to be Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$ 13500.00), payable in  
City Warrants drawn on the general fund in accordance with the  
following terms \$2750.00 payable within ten days after delivery  
and acceptance. Balance in three equal yearly payments at 6%  
per annum. for one complete Standard Stutz Fire apparatus per  
specifications made a part hereof  
Section-2-

Inasmuch as the objects to be obtained by this Ordinance  
will be of great benefit to the people of the City of Warrenton,  
and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this Ordinance  
should take effect as soon as possible so that the health, peace  
and safety of the City of Warrenton may be preserved, an emergency  
is hereby declared to exist and this section therefore shall take  
effect when approved by the affirmative vote of all the Commissioners  
of the City of Warrenton, and this Ordinance shall then be in full  
force and operative immediately after its passage and approval by the  
Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
