

ORDINANCE NO28_A

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE IMPROVEMENT OF THIRD STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH MAIN STREET AND RUNNING THENCE EASTERLY ALONG THIRD STREET ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE RAIL ROAD SPUR TO AN INTERSECTION WITH HEMLOCK STREET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY,

Whereas heretofore on the 6th day of February 1923 the City of Commission of the City of Warrenton passed a resolution declaring its intention of improving Third street from its intersection with main street and running thence easterly along third street on the south side of the rail road spur to an intersection with Hemlock street, and

Whereas on the 20th day of February 1923 the City of Commission of the City of Warrenton passed an Ordinance directing said Improvement to be made and entered into a contract therefor, and that said work and improvement has been made in conformity with a resolution and Ordinance directing said Improvement to be made and plans and specifications filed with the Auditor and Police Judge, and is now ready to be accepted,

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS,

SECTION 1 The Improvement of third street from its intersection with Main street and running Easterly along the south side of the Railway spur to an intersection with Hemlock street in the City of Warrenton having been completed in accordance with the plans and specifications and contract entered into for the making of said improvement and all things been done and complied with in accordance therewith, the said Improvement is hereby accepted.

Section 2 In as much as the object to be obtained from this Ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the City of Warrenton, and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this Ordinance should be take effect as soon as possible so that the health, peace and safety

of the people of the City of Warrenton may be preserved, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this section therefore shall take effect when approved by the affirmative vote of all of the Commissioners of the City of Warrenton and this Ordinance shall then be in full force and effect and operative immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
