

ORDINANCE NO. 30

AN ORDINANCE authorizing THE D.L.KELLY LOGGING CO, to construct maintain and operate a single line of railroad through ~~the length~~ ^{an} of 3rd, street, in the City of Warrenton.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section, 1. The D.L.KELLY LOGGING CO, their successors and assigns are hereby authorized and licensed to construct, maintain and ^{end of RR} operate a line of single track railroad from ^{where the main RR} ~~the westerly extremity~~ ^{line crosses} of 3rd, street to its easterly extremity, or such portion thereof as may be desired, together with the right to operate and maintain thereover rolling stock, steam and power locomotives and engines, such track to be constructed and maintained on the established grade of said City, as ~~is~~ maintained, and ~~such grade not to be~~ ~~changed without the consent of the said D.L.Kelly Logging Co, or~~ ~~their assigns.~~ Provided that the entire costs and expenses of constructing and maintaining and operating the same shall be borne and paid by said D.L.Kelly Logging Co, and without cost to the City of Warrenton.

Section 2. ^{Street} All crossings shall be built and maintained by said ^{and at the cost of} D.L.Kelly & Co, or their assigns, ~~between the rails, and for one foot~~ ~~on the outside of each thereof,~~ which crossings shall be built and maintained at each street crossing, when directed by the Common Council of said City. ^{Said street to be planked to a width of sixteen feet between Main & Spruce streets}

Section, 3. The rights hereby granted to be held to continue during ^{10 years from passing of this Ordinance} ~~use and occupancy, or either,~~ and to cease when rails shall be removed, and continue so removed for the period of six months.
