

ORDINANCE NO. 34.

Introduced by Mr. J. Bosshart.

An ordinance directing the City Auditor and Police Judge to advertise for bids for the construction of a City jail.

The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows:-

*Call for bids for city jail*

Section 1. The Auditor and Police Judge is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for ten days in the Astoria Budget and by posting notices thereof in three public places in the City of Warrenton for ten days, for bids for the erection, construction and completion of a City Jail for the City of Warrenton, in accordance with the plans and specifications thereof, as the same now appear on file with J. A. Eakin, at #426 Commercial Street, in the City of Astoria, Oregon; said jail to be constructed upon Lot Three (3) of Block Nine (9) of the City of Warrenton, as laid out and recorded by D. K. Warren, at such place as may be designated by the Committee on Public Property. Each bidder shall accompany his bid with a certified check equal to 10% of the amount of his bid as a forfeiture to the City of Warrenton, in case he fails to enter into a contract with the City of Warrenton, in accordance therewith, if said bid is accepted, and said notice shall also reserve the right on the part of the said City of Warrenton to reject any and all of said bids.

*Committee to open bids & report*

Section 2. That at the time specified in said notice, after the period of advertisement has expired, the committee on public property of said City of Warrenton, shall open and audit all bids received thereon and report the same to the City Council at its next meeting thereafter held (special or regular) with their recommendations thereon.
