

ORDINANCE NO. 35-

INTRODUCED BY _____

An Ordinance declaring the intention to build a side-walk on the south side of Second Street from the east side of Hemlock Street to the West side of Main Street.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1. That it is hereby declared to be the determination and intention of the common council to build a wooden side-walk six feet wide, to be constructed on the south side of Second Street, between the east side of Hemlock Street and the West side of Main Street, as follows:- The crossings to be made of 3 x 12 fir planking, laid length-wise and laid on 3 x 12 cedar mud sills, six feet in length, laid every ten feet, and the walk to be built of 1 1/2 x 8 inch planks, six feet long, surfaced on one side, laid on four stringers 2 x 6 set equi-distant, in twenty foot lengths, stringers to be supported by cedar mud sills 3 x 12 six feet long, placed every ten feet, so blocked up as to bring the decking to an even surface, and so placed as to support the ends of the stringers.

Section 2. That the expense of making said improvement be assessed upon the following described property abutting upon the said improvement, to-wit:-

Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), and Ten (10) of Block Two (2). Lot Ten (10) of Block Three (3) and Lot One (1) of Block Nine (9), all in the ~~Town~~ ^{City} of Warrenton, as laid out and recorded by D. K. Warren.

Section 3. That notice of the intention of the council to make said improvement, be given by the Recorder, by posting notice thereof in three public places in said City of Warrenton, for one day at least one week prior to the next meeting of the common council.
