

An ordinance to restrain, regulate and prohibit the discharge of ~~fire arms~~, fire works, fire crackers and other detonating works of all descriptions.

The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows:-

Sec. 1. Any person or persons who shall ~~fire off or discharge~~ any ordnance, gun, pistol or rifle or any other fire arm within the City Limits of the City of Warrenton, ~~or shall~~ discharge, explode or burn any fire works or fire crackers, or other detonating or explosive works, the explosion of which is productive of fire in that portion of the City of Warrenton, described as follows, to-wit:- fill in the attached description of boundary

shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the Police Court, shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five (5) Dollars nor not more than Three Hundred (300) Dollars, or by imprisonment in the ^{city} ~~County~~ Jail not to exceed One Hundred (100) days;

~~PROVIDED, that the Mayor may permit upon National Holidays and other public celebrations and occasions, such use as may be deemed within his discretion, advisable.~~
