ORDINANCE NO. 37

An Ordinace to improve Second Streetfrom the East side of Hemlock Street to the West side of Main Street, by building a side walk on the South side thereof.

WHEREAS due and legal notice of the determination and intention of the Common Council of the City of Astoria to make the improvement already mentioned has been given, as appears from the proof of publication on file with the Auditor and Police Judge, and the City Surveyor has made and filed estimates of the costs and expenses of constructing said improvement and specifications for the proposed work, and . no...remonstrance has been filed against said improvement;

THEREFORE THE CITY OF ASTORIA DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Med-That said Second Street from the South side of Hemlock Street and the West side of Main, by building a side walkon the south sid of said Second Street, as follows:-The crossings to be made of 3X12 Fir planking laid lengthwise and laid on three by twelve Cedar mud-sills, six feet in length laid every ten feet, and the walk to be build of 11/2 X 8 inch planks, six feet long, surfaced on one side, laif on four stringers 2 X 6 set equi-distant, in twenty foot lengths, stringers to be supported by Cedar mud sills 3 X 12 six feet long placed every ten fet, so blocked up as to bring the decking to an even surface. and so placed as to support the ends of the stringers. Section 2. The committee on Streets and Public Ways be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement and to report the same to the Council and upon the acceptance of the lowest bid by the Council to enter into contract with such bidder for the construction of the improvement.

That said improvement shall be made strictly as provided by the plans and specifications and this ordinance and that the contractor shall have full charge of the work and shall be responsible for all accidents and injuries occurring upon the street during the progress of the work and save the City harmless from all damages on account of an injury to any person happening upon the said portion of said street while in the course of construction.

That payments shall be made in warrants of the City of **Astoria**, either upon a special fund constituted to defray the costs and expenses of the improvement or upon the general fund, or partly upon each fund or that payment be made in street bonds at par payable on or before five years and drawing interest at 6 per cent per annum, and that payment shall be made within ninety days from the time the improvement shall be accepted. The contractors shall be required to give bond with two or more sureties in the penal sum of \$...?

That planking and timbers upon any portion of said street after the same is taken up by Warrenton the contractor may be taken by the City of **Astoria** and removed, and all old planking and timbers not required by the City and all rubbish upon the streets after the improvement is completed shall be removed by the contractor.
