ENTITLED, An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No 21 of the City of Warrenton, Entitled , An Ordinance to Restrain the use of fire arms and the firing of Guns within the Corporate Limits of the <sup>City</sup> ~~Town~~ of Warrenton.

The City of Warrenton does Ordain as follows:

Section 1,- That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 21 of the City of Warrenton be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:-

Section 1, It shall be unlawful for any person within <sup>that portion of the</sup> ~~the~~ corporate limits of the City of Warrenton <sup>which lies west of the west-line of Warrenton Park.</sup> to discharge or fire any rifle, gun, pistol or revolver except in cases where the same is actually used at the time for the purpose of killing or slaughtering animals in a slaughter house or abbattoir.

SECTION 2. That Section 2 of Ordinance No 21 of the City of Warrenton, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:-

Section 2, It shall be unlawful for any person within <sup>that portion of the</sup> ~~the~~ Corporate <sup>which lies west of the west-line of Warrenton Park</sup> limits of the City of Warrenton, to fire, or discharge any rifle, pistol, revolver or shot-gun upon the premises owned or belonging to the person so firing or discharging the same, except upon permission in writing first obtained, for good cause shown, from the City Marshall,

Section 3, That Section three of the Ordinance No. 21 of the City of Warrenton be and it is hereby amended so as to read as follows,

Section 3, Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof before the Auditor and Police Judge, shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five , or more than Fifty Dollars, or by imprisonment in the City Jail not less than two nor more than twenty days or both such fine and imprisonment
