

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE OPERATING AND CONDUCTING OF A MANUFACTURING PLANT WHERE THERE IS MANUFACTURED FISH MEAL AND FISH OIL MADE FROM FISH OR ANY PART THEREOF IN THE CITY OF WARRENTON AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE A PUBLIC NUISANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

~~XXXXXX~~ THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

SECTION-1-

No person persons, co-partnership, company corporation or association shall engage in the manufacture of fish meal and fish oils made from fish or any part thereof, nor shall any manufacturing establishment or plant be permitted to operate within the corporate limits of the City of Warrenton, Clatsop County, State of Oregon.

SECTION-2-

Any person, persons, co-partnership, company. corporation or association who shall hereafter accumulate or cause to be accumulated fish or any parts of fish in its raw state or otherwise for the purpose of ~~cook~~ cooking the same up for the manufacture of fish meal and fish oils or any other product made from fish heads or from the offal from fish within the corporate limits of the City of Warrenton shall be deemed guilty of creating a public nuisance, except however, the provisions shall not be construed herein so as to prohibit the canning of fish or the curing of the same for the public market for eatable purposes.

SECTION-3-

Any person, persons, co-partnership, company , corporation or association violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof in the municipal court of the City of Warrenton, Oregon be punished by a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than ~~\$50.00~~ \$300.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not less than five (5) days nor more than fifty (50) days. Each day's violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be ~~deemed a separate offense~~ deemed a separate offense.

SECTION-4-

Inasmuch as the objects of this Ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the City of Warrenton and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this Ordinance should take effect as soon as possible so that the health, peace and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Warrenton may be preserved, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ~~Ordinance~~ section therefor shall take effect when approved by the affirmative vote of all of the members of the Commission of the City of Warrenton and this Ordinance shall then be in full force and operative immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
