

ORDINANCE No. 48

An Ordinance providing for the time and place of holding the general election of the City of Warrenton; appointing judges and Clerks of election, and for notice of such election.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Section, 1 A General Election of the City of Warrenton shall be held on the 6th day of January 1909, that being the first Wednesday after the First day of January 1909, for the purpose of electing One Mayor for the term of one year and Two Council-men for the term of two years. The Poling place shall be at Nanewas Falls, and the poles shall be open from 9 o'clock A. M. until 5 o'clock P. M. of said day.

Section, 2 C. F. Sester, G. W. Moore, J. Ross are hereby appointed Judges of said election and E. B. Seavey & W. P. Korner are hereby appointed Clerks of said election, and the Auditor and Police Judge is hereby directed to give ten days notice of such election, specifying the officers to be elected, and the time and place of holding said election, by posting the same in three public places in the City of Warrenton, at least ten days prior to the day of holding such election.
