ORDINANCE NO....⁴⁹....

An Ordinance providing for the Improvement of Third Street from a point six feet West of the center of Hemlock Street to the East line of Lot one in Block nine in the City of Warrenton as laid out and recorded by D. K. Warren, and from the West line of the Right of Way of the Astoria & Columbia River Railroad Company to a point four and one-half feet East weak of the center of Elm Street, by grading the same to a width of nine feet through the center thereof to a uniform, common grade, and by planking the same to a width of nine feet through the center thereof and bridging the slough.

WHEREAS due and legal notice of the determination and intention of the Common WARRENTON Council of the City of Astoria to make the improvement already mentioned has been given, as appears from the proof of publication on file with the Auditor and Police Judge, and the City Surveyor has made and filed estimates of the costs and expenses of constructing said improvement and specifications for the proposed work, and...no.remonstrance has been filed against said improvement;

WARRENTON

THEREFORE THE CITY OF ASTORIAN DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That Third Street from a point six feet West of the Section 1. center of Hemlock Street to the East line of Lot one in block nine in the Town of Warrenton as laid out and recorded by D. K. Warren, and from the West line of the Astoria & Columbia River Railroad Company right of way to a point 4-1/2 feet East of the center of Elm Street be improved in the following manner, to-wit; By grading said street to a uniform, even grade throughout to a width of nine feet through the center thereof, excepting the slough between Elm and Date Street, and by planking the same to a width of nine feet through the center thereof, excepting said slough, with 3 x 12 inch planks laid on four stringers placed equi-distant and the stringers to be 43x 6 laid on mud sills of the same dimension, the mud sills to be so placed as to support the ends of the stringers, the planking to be nailed with 6-inch nails, two in each end and one in each of the middle stringers on alternate sides of the planks, all mud sills to be firmly imbedded in the ground, and all planking and timbers to be used in said improvement to be of sound fir and of suitable condition for such The bridge across said slough to be constructed in accordance with work. the plans and specifications thereof on file with the Auditor and Police Judge of the City of Warrenton.

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Section 2. The committee on Streets and Public Ways be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement and to report the same to the Council and upon the acceptance of the lowest bid by the Council to enter into contract with such bidder for the construction of the improvement.

That said improvement shall be made strictly as provided by the plans and specifications and this ordinance and that the contractor shall have full charge of the work and shall be responsible for all accidents and injuries occurring upon the street during the progress of the work and save the City harmless from all damages on account of an injury to any person happening upon the said portion of said street while in the course of construction.

That payments shall be made in warrants of the City of Astoria, either upon a special fund constituted to defray the costs and expenses of the improvement or upon the general fund, or partly upon each fund or that payment be made in street bonds at par payable on or before five years and drawing interest at 6 per cent per annum, and that payment shall be made within ninety days from the time the improvement shall be accepted. The contractors shall be required to give bond with two or more sureties in the penal sum of \$...... conditioned for the faithful performance of the contract.

That planking and timbers upon any portion of said street after the same is taken up by the contractor may be taken by the City of Astoria and removed, and all old planking and timbers not required by the City and all rubbish upon the streets after the improvement is

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completed shall be removed by the contractor.
