

An ordinance adopting, confirming and approving estimates of budget of expenses and receipts as made and filed by the "levying Board" and "Budget Committee" of the City of Warrenton, for year 1924; levying taxes for general municipal purposes, for bond interest and sinking fund purposes and for all other purposes for the City of Warrenton, upon the 1923 tax roll, all for year 1924, and declaring an emergency.

THE City of WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1; That the estimates of budget of expenses and receipts as made and filed by the levying board and budget committee of the City of Warrenton for year 1924 upon the 1923 tax roll, as hereto attached and made a part hereof as though set out in full herein, and all acts, matters and things had and done in connection therewith be and the same are herewith adopted, confirmed and approved.

Section 2; That there be and is hereby levied a tax for general municipal purposes for the City of Warrenton, for year 1924, upon the 1923 tax roll the sum of \$25,483.50.

Section 3; That there be and is hereby levied a tax for Bond interest purposes for the City of Warrenton for year 1924 upon the 1923 tax roll, the sum of \$34,554.94.

Section 4; That there be and is hereby levied a tax for Sinking fund purposes for the City of Warrenton, for year 1924 upon the 1923 tax roll, the sum of \$10,582.00.

Section 5; That there be and is hereby levied a tax for all other purposes as specified in the estimates and budget made and filed by the levying board and budget committee of the city of Warrenton, and duly adopted by ~~said~~ a majority of the qualified voters at tax budget meeting held on the 5th day of February, 1924, for year 1924, upon the 1923 tax roll, the sum of \$70,820.44, all as appears from the said estimates and budget attached hereto and made a part hereof and marked and numbered "Estimates and Budget" for the city of Warrenton, for year 1924.

Section 6; That all of the taxes levied as hereinbefore specified, are levied upon all property, both real and personal within the corporate limits of the City of Warrenton, which is taxable by law for State and County purposes .

Section 7; Inasmuch as the objects to be obtained by this ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the City of Warrenton, and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this ordinance should take effect as soon as possible so that the health, peace and safety of the ^{people of} City of Warrenton may be preserved, and so that the government of said city may properly function, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this section therefore shall take effect when approved by the affirmative vote of all the members of this commission, and this ordinance shall then be in full force and effect and operative immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
