An ordinance accepting the improvement of Garfield Avenue, from its intersection with the north side of the hardsurfaced road on Albany avenue ;thence running north along the center of said Garfield avenue to Portland Avenue,thence in an Easterly direction along Portland Avenue to a point 100 feet west of Arthur ~~xxxxxx~~ street,or stopping at the bridge across the slough,and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance Number 67 A

The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows:
Section 1:- That the improvement of Garfield Avenue from its intersection with the North side of the hardsurfaced road on Albany Avenue;thence running north along the center of said Garfield Avenue to Portland Avenue;thence in an easterly direction along Portland Avenue to a point 100 feet west of Arthur Street, or stopping at the bridge across the Slough,as improved by John Slotte and Company,contractors,under their contract with the City of Warrenton,and as accepted by the Assistant manager of the City of Warrenton,be and the said improvement is hereby accepted by the City of Warrenton.

Section 2:- Inasmuch as the objects to be obtained from this ordinance will be of great benefit to the City of Warrenton,and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this ordinance should ~~xxxx~~ take effect as soon as possible so that the health,peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton may be preserved, and its credit maintained,an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this section therefore shall be adopted when approved by the affirmative vote of all members of the Commission and this ordinance shall then be in full force and effect and operative immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor of the City of Warrenton.
