2 An ordinance licensing Bill Posters and Regulating the Posting
3 of Bills and constructing of Bill Boards, in the City of Warrenton,
4 Oregon, providing a penalty for the violation thereof, repealing all
5 ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith and declaring
6 an emergency.

7 The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows:

8 Section 1;- Bill Posters shall pay an annual license of \$ 25⁰⁰
9 or a quarterly license of \$ 6²⁵, and no person or persons,
10 firm, company, or corporation shall post any sign or advertisement
11 upon any bill board or on the side of any building or distribute
12 or tack any advertising matter upon any street, building, post or
13 other structure within the limits of the City of Warrenton, Oregon,
14 without first obtaining a license so to do as in this ordinance
15 provided. Provided, however, that this ordinance shall not apply to
16 a sign erected by a merchant or other person upon his own premises,
17 or to election notices, or hand bills or advertisements relating
18 to political matters.

19 Section 2;- It shall be the duty of the owner of any bill board
20 now constructed contrary to the provisions of this ordinance to
21 remove the same within 48 hours after notice so to do by the
22 Chief of Police of the City of Warrenton.

23 Section 3;- Any person violating any of the provisions of this
24 ordinance upon conviction thereof before the Auditor and Police
25 Judge shall be punished by a fine of not less than ~~\$~~5.00 nor more
26 than \$50.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail not less than two
27 nor more than twenty-five days, or by both such fine and
28 imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

29 Section 4;- That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict
30 with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

31 Section 5;- Inasmuch as the objects to be obtained by this ordinance
32 will be of great benefit to the people of the City of Warrenton,
33 and there exists an urgent necessity that this ordinance should

1 take effect as soon as possible so that the health, peace and
2 safety of the people of the City of Warrenton may be preserved,
3 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this section therefore
4 shall take effect when approved by the affirmative vote of all the
5 members of the Commission of the City of Warrenton and this ordinance
6 shall then be in full force and operative immediately after its
7 passage and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
