

Ordinance No 75

An ordinance providing for a general municipal election to be held on Wednesday the 3rd day of January, 1912.

The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows:-

Section 1. That a general municipal election shall be held on Wednesday the 3rd day of January, 1912 at which elections shall be elected a Mayor, three Councilmen for the ~~less~~ term of two years.

Section 2. That the Council

Section 7. If any political party shall file with the Auditor and Police Judge, a list of its nominees, the said election ballot as provided for under the general election laws of this state, said Auditor shall ~~for~~ have printed a ballot to conform as closely as possible with the form above set forth and which said ballot shall have printed the list of candidates of such political party.
