

1 An ordinance providing for a general municipal election in and for  
2 the City of Warrenton, Clatsop County, Oregon, to be held on the  
3 4th day of November A.D. 1924, in said city, county and State, for the  
4 purpose of electing municipal officers, and submitting to the Electors  
5 of said city for their approval or rejection the question of Funding  
6 or redeeming an indebtedness of said city incurred on account of the  
7 purchase of Fire Engine and Fire Apparatus for the said City of  
8 Warrenton, and declaring an emergency.

9 THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

10 Section 1, That a general election in and for the City of Warrenton,  
11 Clatsop County, Oregon, is hereby declared to be held in said city, county  
12 and State on the 4th day of November, A.D. 1924.

13 Section 2, That at said general election there shall be elected one  
14 (1) Commissioner of and for the City of Warrenton, for the term of  
15 three (3) years from the 2nd day of January, 1925.

16 Section 3, That the entire city of Warrenton shall constitute one  
17 election precinct, and the polling place for said general election shall  
18 be the city hall of said city of Warrenton, and the polls for such  
19 election shall open at eight (8) o'clock, a.m., and remain open until  
20 eight (8) o'clock, p.m., at which time said polling place shall close.

21 Section 4, That W. P. Hanner, and R. D. Kelson  
22 and C. C. Munson, are hereby appointed Judges of the  
23 said general election, and C. E. Kelson and Mrs. J. H. District  
24 \_\_\_\_\_ are hereby appointed Clerks of said election, if any  
25 Judge or Clerk fails to attend and serve at the opening of the polls,  
26 the judges of election may appoint another in his place. If all the  
27 judges fail to attend the legal voters present at any polling place  
28 may appoint others in their stead.

29 Section 5, The Auditor and Police Judge of the City of Warrenton, be and  
30 he is hereby authorized and directed to submit to the electors of the  
31 City of Warrenton, at said general election provided herein, the question  
32 of issuing funding bonds of the said city as specified in Ordinance  
33 number 77A, passed by the Commission of the City of Warrenton,  
34 on the 7th day of October, 1924, and approved by the Mayor of said City



on the 7th day of October, 1924, providing for the issue of said funding bonds.

Section 6, That notice of said election, containing a copy of the said ordinance number 77A, to fund a certain indebtedness of the City of Warrenton, together with the question as the same shall appear on the official ballot, stating when and where said election will be held, together with the names of the Judges and Clerks appointed by the City of Warrenton for said election, shall be given by the Auditor and Police Judge of said city, by publishing such notice in two successive issues of the "Warrenton News" a weekly newspaper published in the said city of Warrenton, Clatsop County, Oregon, such publication to be made in the issues thereof dated October 24 and 31, 1924, and by posting a copy of such notice at three public places in said city for a period of ten (10) days prior to said general election, and such publication and posting of said notice shall be sufficient, without mailing out to the electors of said city, or to anyone whomsoever, said notice, or any pamphlet or folder containing the same, or at all.

Section 7, Inasmuch as the objects to be obtained by this ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the city of Warrenton, and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this ordinance should take effect as soon as possible so that the health, peace and safety of the people of the city of Warrenton may be preserved and its credit maintained, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this section therefore shall be adopted when approved by the unanimous vote of all the Commissioners of the city of Warrenton, and this ordinance shall then be in full force and operative immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.

Section 8; That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and are hereby repealed.

Passed by the commission of Warrenton, this 7th day of October, 1924.
