

Ordinance 78.

An ordinance appropriating out of the special fund constituted for the purpose of defraying the costs and expenses of improving Elm Street from a point $4\frac{1}{2}$ feet south of the center line of Third Street to a point $4\frac{1}{2}$ feet south of the center line of Fourth Street, the sum of \$2,750.00 in favor of Henry Lee in payment of said improvement.

Section 1. The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows. That there be and there is hereby appropriated out of the special fund constituted for the purpose of defraying the costs and expenses of improving Elm Street from a point $4\frac{1}{2}$ feet south of the center line of Third Street to a point $4\frac{1}{2}$ feet south of the center line of Fourth Street, the sum of \$2,750.00 in favor of Henry Lee in payment of his contract with said City for said improvement under the ordinance providing therefor.

Section 2. That upon the passage and approval of this ordinance the Auditor & Police Judge shall draw a warrant in said amount in favor of said Henry Lee.
