

Ordinance No 83

An Ordinance appropriating out of the special fund constituted for the purpose of defraying the costs and expenses of improving Third Street from the West side of Humboldt Street to the East side of Main Street, the sum of \$3200 in favor of J. Tucker in payment of said improvement

The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows:
Section 1. That there be and there is hereby appropriated out of the special fund constituted for the purpose of defraying the costs and expenses of improving Third Street from the West side of Humboldt Street to the East side of Main Street the sum of \$3200 in favor of J. Tucker in payment of his contract with said City for said improvement under the ordinance providing therefor

Section 2. That upon the passage and approval of this ordinance the Auditor & Police Judge shall draw a warrant in said amount in favor of said J. Tucker.
