

Ordinance No. 87

An ordinance appropriating out of the special fund constituted for the purpose of defraying the costs and expenses of improving Fourth Street from the West side of Nembler Street to the East side of Elm Street the sum of \$1444.00 in favor of J. L. Tucker in payment of said improvement

The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows.  
Section 1 That there be and there <sup>hereby</sup> is appropriated out of the special fund constituted for the purpose of defraying the costs and expenses of improving Fourth Street from the West side of Nembler Street to the East side of Elm Street the sum of \$1444.00 in favor of J. L. Tucker in payment of his contract with said City for said improvement under the ordinance providing therefor.

Section 2. That upon the passage and approval of this ordinance, the Auditor and Police Judge shall draw a warrant in said amount in favor of said J. L. Tucker.
