

Ordinance No. 85

An ordinance providing for the construction of a city hall on lot 3 of block 9 of Warrenton addition to Astoria

The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows:-

Section 1. That there be and there is hereby ordered constructed on lot 3 of block 9 of Warrenton addition to Astoria, a city hall for said city of Warrenton.

Section 2. That the cost of ~~said~~ said city hall shall be constructed at a total cost not exceeding \$1200.00 and upon plans and specifications prepared by John W. Detrick and now on file with the Auditor and Police Judge.

Section 3. That the Committee

on Public Property be and it
is hereby ordered to call for
bids for the construction
of said building and the
Auditor and Police Judge be
and he is hereby ordered to
advertise for such bids under
the direction of said Committee,
~~or~~ which advertisement shall
be by posting notices thereof
for ~~one~~ at least one week
in three public places in
said City.

Section 4 That said Committee
shall open said bids at ~~some~~
~~time~~ such time as may ~~be~~ be
deemed advisable and
~~for~~ report the same, together
with their recommendations,
thereon, at the next regular
meeting of the Council.

Section 5 That an emergency is
hereby declared to exist and the
peace, safety and health of the
people of the City of Waukegan

requires that this ordinance should take effect as soon as passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor and therefore this ordinance section shall go into effect when approved by the affirmative vote of 3/5 of the members of the Council and this ordinance shall go into effect when passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor.
