

Ordinance No 86

An ordinance levying a special tax of three ^{one each dollar} dollars upon the assessable ^{for year 1912} property of the City of Warrenton for the purchase of building a city hall for said City of Warrenton.

Whereas it is deemed advisable that a city hall should be constructed for the use of said city of Warrenton and whereas, it is deemed advisable to levy a special tax of 3 mills upon the assessable property of the City of Warrenton upon the tax roll for the year 1912 to partly defray the cost and expense of constructing said city hall. Now therefore

The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows:-

Section 1. That there be and there

is hereby levied a special
tax of three mills upon
each dollar of assessed
valuation of the property
within the City of Warrenton
upon the tax roll for the
year 1912. ~~For~~ which said
Special tax is levied for the
express purpose of partly
defraying the cost and
expense of building a city
hall in the City Hall of
Warrenton.

Section 2. That the Auditor
and Police Judge be and he
