

An Ordinance appropriating out of the "^{Industrial} Dock Fund" of the City of Warrenton, the sum of \$200.00, and confirming, and approving all acts, matters and things had and done in connection therewith, the said sum being appropriated for the benefit of Hans Louwald, for services rendered and to be rendered the city of Warrenton, Oregon.

Whereas, the city of Warrenton, is vitally interested in the outcome of certain proposed legislation at Salem, Oregon, as pertains to "Trolling", and

Whereas, it is necessary that the city of Warrenton, assist in combatting attempts to change the law at present in force governing "Trolling", and

Whereas, a warrant in the said sum of \$200.00 has heretofore been drawn, by the Auditor and Police Judge, under authority of the Commission of the said City, now therefore;

The city of Warrenton does ordain as follows:

Section 1; That the sum of \$200.00 be and is hereby appropriated out of the "^{Industrial} Dock Fund", for the benefit of ~~Trollers Association~~, for services rendered and to be rendered the city of Warrenton, in the matter as specified in the foregoing preamble.

Section 2. That all acts matters and things had and done by the Commission and by the Auditor and Police Judge of the City of Warrenton relative to the above matter, including the drawing of the said warrant by the Auditor and Police Judge, be and each of said acts, matters and things in connection therewith be and is herewith confirmed and approved.
