1 An ordinance confirming special assessment Roll number 64 of
2 the City of Warrenton, and declaring an emergency.

3 WHEREAS; the improvement of Sixth street and Cedar street
4 commencing at the intersection of sixth street with Main street
5 thence running West along the center of Sixth street to its
6 intersection with the West line of Cedar street; thence turning
7 and running North along the center line of Cedar street to its
8 intersection with fourth street, in the City of Warrenton, Oregon,
9 has been completed by R.D.Kelson and R.E.Wells, co-partners,
10 contractor's, under their contract with the City of Warrenton,
11 and WHEREAS, said improvement has been duly accepted by the
12 Commission of the City of Warrenton, and a statement of the
13 entire cost of the same, together with a description of the
14 property benefited thereby, and the names of the owners, or
15 reputed owners thereof, as described in the report of the
16 committee on estimates, as adopted by the Commission, and all of
17 the costs and expenses as provided by the charter of the City
18 of Warrenton, has been duly included in an assessment duly filed
19 and a hearing thereon has been duly held as provided by law, and
20 said assessment roll which is assessment roll number 64 of the
21 City of Warrenton, Oregon, has been duly equalized and passed
22 upon and determined and adjusted by the said commission,

23 Now therefore,

24 THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

25 Section 1:- That Assessment Roll number 64 made for the purpose
26 of defraying the costs and expenses of improving Sixth street
27 and Cedar street, commencing at the intersection of Sixth street
28 with Main street, thence running west along the center of Sixth
29 street to its intersection with the west line of Cedar street;
30 thence turning and running North along the center of Cedar
31 street to its intersection with fourth street in the City of

1 Warrenton, Oregon, as made and filed, determined and passed upon by
2 the Commission of the City of Warrenton, and the Board of estimates,
3 and duly equalized, and now on file and marked "Special Assessment
4 Roll number 64", be and the same is hereby confirmed and approved,
5 and the same is made payable on or before the 4 day of March
6 _____, 1925.

7 Section 2;- That after the passage and approval of this ordinance
8 by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton, the said assessment Roll
9 number 64 shall be spread upon the docket of city liens of the
10 City of Warrenton, and collected as provided by law.

11 Section 3;- Inasmuch as the objects to be obtained by this
12 ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the City of
13 Warrenton and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this
14 ordinance take effect as soon as possible, so that the credit of
15 the city of Warrenton may be maintained, and so that the health,
16 peace and safety of the people of the city of Warrenton may be
17 preserved an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this
18 section therefore shall take effect when approved by the
19 affirmative vote of all the members of the Commission of the City
20 of Warrenton and this ordinance shall then be in full force and
21 effect and operative immediately upon its passage and approval
22 by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
