

Ordinance No 90

An ordinance regulating the speed of vehicles ~~and~~ within the limits of the City of Warrenton.

The City of Warrenton does ordains as follows:-

Section 1: That no ~~vehicle~~ ~~shall~~ ~~run~~ person shall drive, run or operate any vehicle upon any of the public streets within the city of Warrenton at a greater rate of speed than 18 miles per hour

Section 2:- That the city marshal be and he is hereby instructed to post such signs ^{regarding} and in such places, as is provided for in the state laws governing the subject

Section 3: Any person
violating any of the
provisions of this ordinance,
upon conviction thereof
before the Auditor and
Police Judge, shall be
punished by a fine of not
less than \$2.00 nor more than
\$50.00 or imprisonment in the
city jail not less than 1 day
nor more than 25 days or by
both such fine and
imprisonment, in the
discretion of the court,
