

Ordinance No. 96.

An ordinance accepting the bid of G. L. Moore, in the sum of \$120<sup>00</sup> for the construction of a woodshed closet, and tool room on Lot 3 Block 9 Warrenton Addition to Astoria and authorizing the Committee on Sanitation and Public Property to enter into Contract therefor:

The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows  
Section 1. That the bid of G. L. Moore in the sum of \$120<sup>00</sup> for the construction of a Woodshed, closet and Tool room, on Lot 3 Block 9 Warrenton Addition to Astoria, for the City of Warrenton, be, and the same is hereby accepted.

Section 2. That upon the passage and approval of this ordinance, the Committee on Sanitation and Public Property, be and the same is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the said G. L. Moore, for the construction of said Woodshed, closet and tool room, to be completed as provided for in the plans and specifications, now on file with the Auditor & Police Judge; and the terms of said bid, and not later than 20 days after the passage and approval of this Ordinance
