

Ordinance No. 98

An ordinance providing for a general municipal election to be held on Wednesday the 18th of December 1912

The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows.

Section 1 That a general municipal election, shall be held on Wednesday December 18th 1912. at which election shall be elected a Mayor, two Councilmen for the term of two years, and one Councilman for the term of one year.

Section 2 That the City shall be and it is hereby designated as the place for holding said election

Section 3 That the clerk of said Election shall be

L J Vincent and J L Tucker and the Judges of said election shall be John W Detroit

John Jones and Lester Kindred

Section 4 That J W Detroit shall be the Chairman of said Election Board

Section 5 That the Auditor & Police Judge shall give notice of such election by posting such notice in three Public places within the City of Warrenton for a period of at least 10 days prior to said election

Section 6 That the form of Ballot shall be as follows

General Municipal Election

City of Warrenton Oregon

December 18th 1912

Section 7 If any political party shall file with the Auditor and Police Judge, a list of its nominees as provided for under the general election laws of this state; said Auditor shall have printed a ballot to conform as closely as possible with the form above set forth, and which said ballot shall have printed thereon the list of candidates of such political party, provided that parties shall hand in the names of their nominees at least one week prior to election, to the Auditor and Police Judge
