

ORDINANCE NO. 103

An Ordinance setting apart a sum not exceeding \$500. from the General Fund, and providing that the Water Commission may use the same in preliminary work and investigation towards establishing a municipal water supply and system.

The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows:

*Appropriation for Water Commission*

SECTION I: There is hereby established and set apart from the general fund a special fund of \$500. to be used and applied in preliminary work and investigation towards establishing a municipal water supply and system in the City of Warrenton.

*Defining uses of above appropriation*

SECTION II: Said special fund of \$500., or so much as may be necessary, shall be used exclusively for such work of investigation towards the establishment of a municipal water supply and system, and the same shall <sup>be</sup> and hereby is, placed exclusively in the power and control of the water commission of the City of Warrenton, which said commission is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to use said sum of \$500., or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the purposes indicated in this ordinance. Upon proper request therefore being duly made by said Water Commission, the Auditor and Police Judge is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to draw a city warrant payable unto said Water Commission in any sum not exceeding \$500.; and each requisition shall clearly state its objects and purposes, and said Water Commission shall carefully audit all accounts involved, and make final report of its funds and expenditures to the Common Council, returning such funds drawn as above indicated which may remain unexpended.
