

Ordinance No. 105

An Ordinance appropriating out of a special fund constituted for the purpose of defraying the costs and expenses of redeeming lot S. Block 11 of Warrenton Addition to Astoria from a stay title made to Mrs Anna Coffey for payment of Street Assessment No. 3 recorded in this No. Docket of City Court, against M. A. Scott; the sum of \$50 32 in favor of Anna Coffey.

The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows:

Sectⁿ 1. That here be and there is hereby appropriated out of a special fund constituted for the purpose of defraying the costs and expenses of redeeming lot S. Block 11 Warrenton addition to Astoria as recorded in Street Assessment No. 3. Lot 10. Line 1. of the Docket of City Court against M. A. Scott, from a stay title and deed issued against said lot, in the sum of \$2 7 43 together with cost and expenses of sale as follows. Interest on amount \$3 29 Penality \$8 56 Advertising \$2 50, total \$41 35. Also interest on \$41 28 from March 5th 1912 to Oct. 16th 1913. \$4 23 and taxes for 1912 paid by City County & State, against said lot in the sum of \$4 31 amounting in all to \$50 32

Sectⁿ 2. That upon the passage and approval of this ordinance the Auditor & Police Judge be and he is hereby instructed to issue a warrant for the sum of \$50 32 in favor of Mrs Anna Coffey in full settlement for the same.
