3 An Ordinance ordering, and directing the Auditor and Police
4 Judge of the City of Warrenton, Oregon, to deliver to the Chief
5 of Police of the said City, all assessment rolls made for the
6 purpose of defraying the costs and expenses of improving
7 streets, constructing sewers and installing water mains, in the
8 City of Warrenton, upon which remains delinquent, ~~xx~~ due and unpaid
9 assessments, up to and including Special Assessment Roll number
10 55, of the said City; to issue and attach to each
11 of said Assessment Rolls, a warrant and/or warrants directed to
12 the Chief of Police, commanding him to proceed forthwith to
13 collect the delinquent assessments upon all special assessment
14 Rolls up to and including Assessment roll Number 55,
15 together with the penalty and interest accrued thereon, and
16 pay the same to the Auditor and Police Judge, together with the
17 costs of collection, and return the warrant and assessment Roll,
18 with his doings, endorsed thereon, within 90 days, from
19 the date of delivery of same to him, and declaring an emergency.

21 WHEREAS; the Auditor and Police Judge of the City of
22 Warrenton has prepared and presented to the City Commission of ~~the~~
23 the City of Warrenton, Oregon, a list, showing all the delinquent
24 and unpaid Special Assessments together with the names of the
25 owners of the property so assessed and delinquent, giving the
26 Lot and Block number and/or description of said property,
27 together with the improvement district number, time of assessment
28 amount and interest due thereon, together with penalty, and the
29 said delinquent Special Assessment Roll, and/or Rolls, up to and
30 including Special assessment Roll number 55, are now in
31 the possession of the Commission, showing amounts paid and
32 unpaid, and

1 WHEREAS;more than sixty (60) days have expired since said
2 Special Assessments were made and Notice given of the
3 Assessments and said Assessments are still unpaid and are due
4 to the City of Warrenton;-

5 NOW THEREFORE;THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
6 Section 1;-

7 That the Auditor and Police Judge of the City of Warrenton,
8 be and he is hereby ordered and directed to deliver to the
9 Chief of Police of the said City of Warrenton,all Special
10 Assessment Rolls of the City of Warrenton,made for the purpose of
11 defraying the costs and expenses of improving streets,
12 constructing sewers and/or installing water mains,in the City
13 of Warrenton,upon which remains delinquent,due and unpaid
14 assessments,up to and including Assessment Roll Number 58

15 all of which said Special Assessment Rolls have heretofore
16 been returned to the Commission by the Auditor and Police Judge.

17 Section 2;-

18 That the Auditor and Police Judge of the City of
19 Warrenton be and he is further ordered,and directed to issue
20 and attach to each of said Special Assessment Rolls,as herein-
21 before specified a warrant and/or warrants directed to the
22 Chief of Police of the said City,commanding him to proceed
23 forthwith to collect the delinquent assessments upon such Roll,
24 and/or Rolls,together with the penalty and interest accrued
25 thereon,and pay the same to the Auditor and Police Judge,
26 together with the costs of collection,for deposit,and ~~x~~ return
27 the warrant and/or warrants and Assessment Roll with his
28 doings endorsed thereon and the receipt of the Auditor and
29 Police Judge for the funds collected to the Commission.

30 Section 3;-

31 That the warrant for collection of such delinquent Assess-
32 ments shall be deemed an execution and shall have the force
33 and effect thereof against the property of any person,firm,

1 Section 3; (Continued)

2 or corporation against which such assessments are levied and
3 ^{which} upon/the same are a lien, and said warrant shall be executed and
4 returned to the Commission in like manner as an execution for
5 the sale of real property upon a decree of foreclosure of a
6 lien thereon.

7 Section 4;-

8 That the warrants must be levied upon the real property
9 covered by the lien for the assessments charged against the
10 same, including the fees of officers, advertising and all
11 expenses of sale and executing the warrant, and/or warrants.

12 Section 5;-

13 That when the owner is unknown the warrant together with
14 the penalty and accrued interest thereon, shall be executed by
15 levying upon each lot or part thereof of such property for the
16 assessments levied thereon, together with the fees of officers,
17 the expense of advertising and sale and selling it separately.

18 Section 6;-

19 That when the property is sold the Chief of Police shall
20 ~~mk~~ make and deliver to the purchaser upon the payment to him of
21 fifty (50¢) cents for the benefit of the city of Warrenton, a
22 certificate of sale therefor, and thereafter if the said property
23 be not redeemed a Deed shall be executed by the Chief of Police
24 to the purchaser thereof or to his assigns at the expiration
25 of the time for redemption, which shall be one (1) year from the
26 date of the issuance of the said certificate and the purchaser
27 shall be entitled to the possession of said property from the
28 day of the sale.

29 X Section 7;-

30 All warrants issued for the collection of the aforesaid
31 delinquent assessments shall be and they are hereby made
32 returnable by the Chief of Police within 90 days from
33 the date of delivery of said warrants to him by the Auditor
34 and Police Judge.

1 Section 8;-

2 Inasmuch as the objects to be obtained by this ordinance
3 will be of great benefit to the people of the City of Warrenton,
4 and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this ordinance
5 should take effect as soon as possible so that the health, peace
6 and safety of the people of the city of Warrenton may be
7 preserved and the credit of the said City maintained, ~~and~~ an
8 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Section therefore
9 shall be adopted when approved by the affirmative vote of all
10 the members of the ~~the~~ Commission, and this ordinance shall then
11 be in full force and effect and operative immediately after
12 its passage and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
