Ordinance Number 111 A

An ordinance appropriating out of the Water Fund of the City of Warrenton, the sum of \$187.70 in favor of the Lewis and Clark Railway Company, in payment of labor, freight and materials furnished the water Department of the city of Warrenton;-

The city of Warrenton does ordain as follows:-

Section 1;-

That there be and is hereby appropriated out of the water fund of the city of Warrenton, the sum of \$187.70 in favor of the Lewis and Clark Railway Company, in payment of labor, freight and materials furnished the water Department of the City of Warrenton.

Section 2;-

That upon the passage and approval of this ordinance the Auditor and Police Judge shall draw a warrant or warrants upon the said fund in favor of the said Company for the amount as specified, being payment of labor, freight and materials furnished the City of Warrenton, by said Company.
