An Ordinance appropriating out of the Water Fund of the City of Warrenton the sum of \$1924.50 for the benefit of the American Wood Pipe Company in payment for purchase of wood pipe for repair of the main line of the water system.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out of the water fund of the city of Warrenton the sum of nineteen hundred twenty-four dollars and fifty cents (\$1924.50) in favor of the American Wood Pipe Company of Tacoma, Washington in payment for the purchase of wood pipe for repair of the main line of the water system of said city.

Section 2. That upon the passage and approval of this Ordinance the Auditor and Police Judge be and he is hereby directed to issue a warrant or warrants upon the said fund in favor of the American Wood Pipe Company for said amount in payment of purchase of wood pipe for repair of the main line of the water system of the city of Warrenton.
